Developed in co-operation with the Austrian Red Cross Blood Donor Centre, this project is very much in demand among school groups grade 4 and above.

Topics dealt with include the components and functions of blood, donating blood, determining blood types, as well as the cardiovascular system in humans and animals. Apart from the popular live projections of microscopic images (“micro-theatre”), the project includes a wealth of objects and hands-on tasks, including a few highlights such as live leeches and fresh hearts – touching opportunities included.
