Guided tours for kindergarten groups and primary school classes 50 minutes

Whether hard or soft, thick shelled or limp, round or angled – there's one thing that all eggs have in common: a baby animal is growing inside. At the museum, children can compare eggs and discover which animal they belong to. A hen's egg is subjected to close inspection inside and out. At the subsequent walk through the zoological collection we can visit spiders, crocodiles, frogs and many other egg-laying animals.

Workshop for primary school classes 3 hours

After a walk through the zoological collection, children will learn about egg-laying animals and their procreation strategies in a fun way. Together we will sort eggs and assign them to their "producers". We will see baby chicks, a snake and a platypus hatch from a (paper) egg, and we will study the structure of a hen's egg from up close.
