



## SOLVE THE MURDER MYSTERY

Workshop suitable for children in school year 5 and above

After a guided tour of the archeological collection, the class is divided into groups.

### Guided tour

CSI Archeology! What do bones tell anthropologists and archeologists? Using original bones and bone fragments, participants learn about the human skeleton. Prehistoric (criminal) cases are then used to showcase methods used in forensic anthropology. The school children find out how the skeleton can reveal details such as signs of illness and injury, or even the possible cause of death.

### Workshop

The school pupils are put into small groups and given the challenge of working together as interdisciplinary research teams to solve a fictitious prehistoric case. They are sent out on their own to gather clues using special investigation methods such as determining the age and gender of a person using only the remains.
